Community Integration through Cooperative Education(CICE)

What is needed to attend the only modified program in Ontario?

- Your Certificate of Accomplishment or be 19 years old
- A willingness to be in the program
- · A level of independence that you do not need to have a support person with you outside of class or tutoring

Who is this program for?

- Students who are on an Individual Education Plan (IEP) and need modifications (changes to what is expected to learn) in order to be successful
- CICE is designed for adults with disabilities or other significant learning challenges/differences who wish to further their education in a community college setting

Some Facts:

- Half of the credits earned will be from specifically designed CICE courses and placement experiences, where students will learn job skills.
- The other half of the credits earned will be from elective course options. Students will have the opportunity to
 select classes from a variety of mainstream programs. They will have a Learning Specialist with them in class to
 take notes and collaborate with teachers to make sure changes to assessments are appropriate
