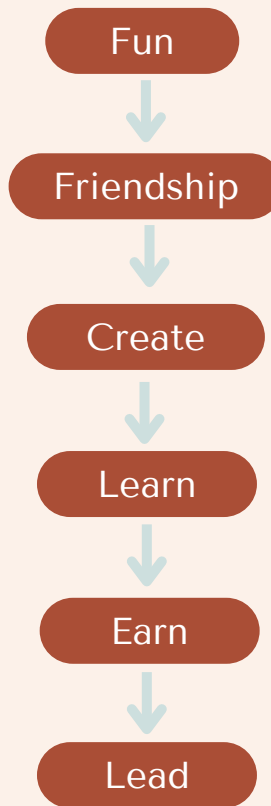
The farm/surroundings/studio are all very peaceful, and a pretty view out of the window will inspire creativity.
